In order to be considered for conversion to a potable supply use, it must meet all requirements of a potable supply well including but not limited to, construction standards, siting, depth, and chemical and bacteriological standards.

If this well is replacing an existing well, the well being replaced must be abandoned and sealed by a master well driller, as per requirements of the water well regulations, and an abandonment report submitted to this department.
